

List of Verification Bodies for Electrical Installations

Accreditation and Approval with the Mexican Technical Regulation NOM-001-SEDE-2005, Instalaciones Eléctricas (utilización)

Verification Bodies for Electrical Installations

The body that carries out verification acts for evaluating the conformity assessment based upon the Mexican Technical Regulation NOM-001-SEDE-2005 Instalaciones Eléctricas (utilización) should be accredited by an Accreditation Body and approved by the Secretaría de Energía, according with the dispositions foreseen under the Ley Federal sobre Metrología y Normalización.

Verification

In order to assess the fulfillment of the Mexican Technical Regulation NOM-001-SEDE-2005 Instalaciones Eléctricas (utilización), the verification bodies carries out, where applicable, eye witnessing or checking by sampling, measurement, laboratory tests, or documents examination.

Conformity Assessment

The comply degree determination with the Mexican Technical Regulation NOM-001-SEDE-2005 Instalaciones Eléctricas (utilización) comprehends the procedures for sampling, calibration, test, certification and verification, among others.

Approval Conditions

Applicants that are willing to become a Verification Body for Electrical Installations must comply with the dispositions established in the summon published at Federal Official Gazette (DOF, by its initials in Spanish language) on August 8th 2006.

To request the approval, they must fill the application format published in the DOF together with the summon above mentioned. This format can be delivered on a maximum 30 natural days period, starting from the date of accreditation, at the Headquarters the Secretaría de Energía, located at Insurgentes Sur 890 lower level, Colonia Del Valle, Zip Code 03100, Benito Juárez, México, D.F., between 9:00 to 15:00 hours.

They must present valid accreditation copy, where applicants are accredited as a Verification Body of Electrical Installations, and the approval application format DG-UVIE-AP-001.

Every Verification Body of Electrical Installations must communicate to the Secretaría de Energía and the mexican accreditation entity (ema, by its initials in Spanish language) if there is any change in the information or conditions, under which its accreditation and approval was granted, in a maximum period of fifteen natural days starting from the date when changes took place.
